Every Student

- **Bible** (required; any translation allowed; NO paraphrases such as *The Message* or *TNIV*; teacher recommendation – a hardcover edition, such as a pew Bible, will hold up for student use over several years; \$10-15 from christianbook.com, Amazon)
- **3 boxes tissue**
- **3 rolls paper towels**
- **3-ring binder(s)** (at least 1 for loose-leaf paper & handouts)
- **loose-leaf paper** (for assignments/quizzes/notes)
- **spiral notebooks** (notes/journals)
- **pencils** (replacement lead/erasers for mechanical pencils)
- **pencil sharpener** (NOT battery operated; for students using regular pencils)
- **blue/black ink pens** (NO metallic or fluorescent colors)
- **red ink pen** (grading only)
- **pencil bag** (w/ holes for 3-ring binder)
- **highlighter(s)**
- **assignment book** (required)
- **index cards** (3"x 5")

- **Colored pencils – box of 12-24 (box of 50 for A&P students)**

Art

- **Pencils (not mechanical)**

Reading Workshop/Lit Seminar

- **spiral notebook or composition book** (80-120 pp. is sufficient; must be used only for this class!)

- **Algebra 1/Geometry/Chemistry/ Physics – scientific calculator** (teacher recommendation – TI-30X IIS \$13 at Wal-Mart/Target/Amazon; Algebra 1 students may NOT use graphing calculators)
- **Algebra 2/Pre-Calculus/Calculus – graphing calculator** (teacher recommendation – TI-83 or TI-84 \$100; DO NOT buy a TI-85 or TI-86; TI-89 excellent for students pursuing math careers, but cannot be used on college entrance exams; calculators may be purchased on eBay at greatly reduced prices – watch condition)
